### **Herm Fessler, 1924 to 2006**

It was with sadness that we learned of Herm's sudden passing. Herm had been a long time member of the MMAC joining prior to 1960. His building and flying skills were outstanding and he was a loyal participant at club events. He had timed a few flights for me two weeks prior, and complained that the binoculars were too heavy to hold for timing long flights.

Herm's reign as club champion began in 1977 and continued until 1984. I heard someone in the family say that his wife threatened to burn the club plaque if he hung it one more year in the house.

In recent years, he has concentrated on the Embryo event, and usually built about 6 of the little models every winter as an offering to the thermal gods the following season. According to Herm, he never tested these models, but just wound them up, and set them on the card table for official flights, and very seldom was beaten in the event. I can remember countless occasions seeing Herm out in the bean fields searching for one of his Embryo flyers.

Herm was a meticulous draftsman and designer and when asked why his license plate said "HOSOFO", one learned that he signed his drawings H.S.F with big o's for periods, and eventually new co-workers were asking who this HOSOFO guy was? So his trade mark kind of stuck.

Herm drew up plans for my hlg, and I still use them for reference when comparing new designs. His plans were very complete and accurate, which matched his life style in all of his work and hobbies.

Fly in peace Herm! We will miss you!
