PONDERINGS DEP'T

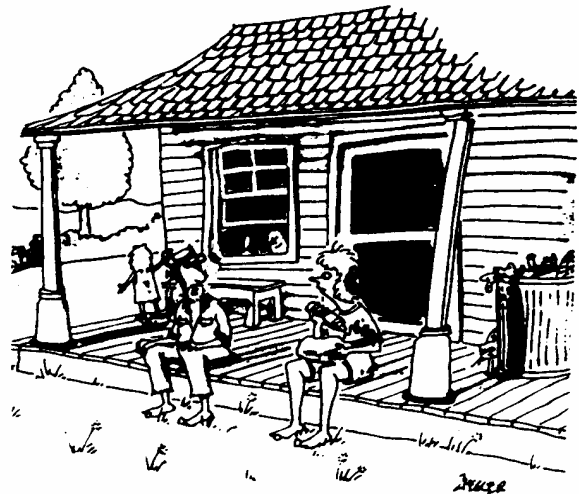
