
## PONDERINGS DEP'T

## PRESIDENT'S PONDERINGS

### **2009, A Magnificent Year for the MMM Club**

As we enter into 2009 I am honored to have been ask by you, the club members to continue on as president for one more year. I hope that I can deliver the kind of leadership this club expects of its leaders. I am not too worried as being the MMM Club president is not a one-man job. The other club leaders, VP Marc Sisk, Sec/Treas Chuck Etherington, newsletter editor Rick Pangell, and our team of Contest Directors are a world-class leadership team that few clubs can match. In addition, this club has a strong active membership who has shown through the years that they are willing to help make the club and its events run smoothly. Also, there is no limit to the flow of good ideas and suggestions which have kept the MMM Club on the leading edge of the national free flight community. I pledge to be open to any and all ideas as they come up.

A wise man once said that, "if you don't know where you are going, any road will take you there." With this in mind here are the 2009 goals as presented at the annual meeting.

### MMM 2009 Goals:

#### **1) Protect the Lowry Range flying field**

We are truly blessed to have a world class field and we will do everything possible to ensure that we have access to it as long as possible. I can't help but to think the current economic downturn has bought us additional time on the field as development plans have been put on hold.

- It is critical that we maintain a good relationship with the Arapaho Hunt Club, so I have asked **Chuck Etherington** to take over this role in place of the late **Art Hillis** who did a magnificent job.

- We must be good stewards of the field. In this regard I have asked **Roland Solomon** to take the lead in this area. His responsibilities will cover such issues as weed control, road maintenance, and what ever else might come up in regards to the physical assets of the field.
- A critical element in our ability to keep the Lowry Range site in a good relationship with the State Land Board. I have asked **Pete McQuade** to continue in this role. Pete has established a very good relationship with the board and his continued relationship will be good for all of us.

#### **2) Keep the character of the MMM Club as we grow.**

The MMM Club is one that values flying more than meetings. We are fortunate to have two flying fields and a group of flyers that like to travel to out of town contests. In order for a club to function under a minimum meeting format, it must have open channels of communication.

- **Rick Pangell** will continue to serve the club as the MaxOut editor and web site manager. The MaxOut is well known around the free flight community as a first class publication, which continues to enhance the club's image.
- **Don DeLoach** will continue to lead the Yahoo discussion group. **Don** first proposed this idea a couple of years ago and it has grown to being a first class channel for communication of club news.
- The MMM monthly contests have been our primary face-to-face meeting format for many years. In addition the CDs of these monthly events are a basic building block of the club leadership. We have lost some of our previous CDs to retirement such as **Roger Maves**, moving away such as **Paul Andrade** and **John Anders**, and

death like the late **Art Hills**. We need to recruit new CDs and I am happy to report that **Mel Gray** and **Marc Sisk** have sent their applications in to AMA.

- The monthly meetings are the primary face-to-face meeting format for the club. Therefore, it is critical that these events meet the needs of the club members. **Randy Reynolds** proposes a new format that was adapted by the club at the annual meeting known as the Scramble. Read more about this exciting change to our laid back monthly meets.
- The MMM by-laws have served as a model for many clubs but it has been a while since they have been reviewed. I will launch a bylaws review process with the goal of having revisions to the club for the 2009 annual meeting.

### **3) Grow The Three MMM Major Championship Contests**

The MMM club is unique in the free flight world in that we currently sponsor three championship contests, Pikes peak Ceiling Climb, FAI Annual, and Rocky Mountain FF Champs. Most clubs are able to host one meet while we have three.

- The duty roster that was used for the 2008 RMC was a success and it will be expanded to cover all three events this year. If you have a skill that you would like to share with the club in running these events please let me know.
- SCAT has launched an expert level of the Americas Cup program known as the Extreme Americas Cup and they have proposed to us that the 14 Rounder should be a part of this program. The club decided to support this so it shall be so.
- We need a new food vendor for the RMC. Carol Hjerleid did an outstanding job in this capacity for the

2008 event but they will be out of state during the 2009 RMC. She is a professional in this area and she has taken the time to write a report on what she did and what she learned in the process. This will be a great help to the 2009 vendor. If you know of anybody who would like to take this project please let any of the club officers know. The deal is they do the work and keep the profits.

### **4) Manage the finances**

The club has benefited from the **Bill Gibbons** estate sale and the fact that our major contests do generate a profit. The email distribution of the Max-Out saves us a few hundred dollars each year. The current economic situation has a mixture of inflation and deflation elements at the same time, which means that it is very difficult for us to plan a budget. Therefore, the club leadership will be using our best judgment to manage the club's money.

- Actively remind members when club dues are due.
- Look for ways to save money for contest awards
- Work with the Land Board to keep lease fees low.

Please let me, or any club officer know if you have any feedback concerning these goals for our club. I and the other officers are here to serve you and to enhance the free flight experience here in Colorado.

Fig is actually a great event to fly. It uses the same rubber motor as P-30 and some of the older construction designs are highly competitive. The Champ Coupe of the 80's is a great example. If anything changed, it's the elimination of the cross section rule so you can use all of those fancy carbon tubes, but 2 minutes is still 2 minutes.
