I would like to develop sound scoring procedures for this event before our regular club contest calendar begins in February. I've solicited responses from a few of you already. It's clear that there are several different ideas on how this event should be run and how it should be counted towards the club championship. Please read the rules and give this some thought. Perhaps we can hold a short meeting during the AZ Free Flight Champs to discuss.

CONTEST REPORT

TURKEY SHOOT

A total of fifteen flyers showed up Sunday November 14th for our "Turkey Shoot" contest despite the cold and breezy morning conditions and were rewarded with an almost perfect flying day after nine AM, when the wind died off and temps rose to the mid-seventies. Thermals were rare but large and strong. They weren't easy to spot, though, unless you could launch under one of Enes Pecenkovic's towline gliders which drifted over the flight line regularly and pointed out the lift to all.

Vintage FAI had only two flyers, Elmer Nelson and Dan Sobala, but they both gave us a great demonstration of the flying ability of these models, even with the added weight and smaller engines required. I know there were a lot of others trying to get a model together and adjusted for the meet, myself included, and Elmer Nelson and I will try to get the event added to the PMAC/TFFC contest schedule for the next season.

Elmer won the event when Dan Sobala had to retire with timer problems after four flights. Timer difficulties plagued many of our strongest competitors...Dick Nelson also ran afoul of sticking timers and had to put his Ignition model away after one flight.

Gene Wicks was the last flyer on the field and his efforts were rewarded with a big pile of National Cup points...watch for his name on the Nat Cup standings when it comes out.

My thanks to all who braved the weather and attended. We had a lot of winter visitors as well as the hoary old 'regulars' and everybody seemed to enjoy the great flying day.
