Meeting was called to order at 7:10 pm.

Old Business

- 1) Minutes of the March meeting were read, and accepted as read
- 2) Treasurers Report – Lynn Chaffee – A one time setup fee for embroidery on the club shirts and hats had been paid, and dues were received.
- 3) Indoor Contest – no comments – Neither Emil or Gary H. were present.
- 4) Outdoor contest – Oct.6 & 7 – Sanction submitted and everything going forward as planned.
- 5) Outdoor Flying sites – No response from the sod farm owner at 203 rd & Pflumm, still hoping to contact. The current site at 183<sup>rd</sup> & Pflumm looks better than ever, the seasonal stream is tiled over and grass cut. Too bad it is too small for large planes!
- 6) Makers Fair – 6/23 & 6/24 – Mike B. has us registered for an indoor table, and we will be building 9 inch foam plate gliders. Mike brought one, and a bunch of plates with the glider laid out, and it flew remarkably well! We want to have other planes on display, and maybe to fly as a demo as well. Peanuts, Delta Darts, and maybe an A-6? Also, Mike B. has ordered 250 more club brochures to hand out. We were down to one in the rack at Hobby Haven, and no more backups.

New Business

- 1) There will be two meetings in May (as well as September) The second Tuesday will be the business meeting at the JC Library as usual, and we will begin flying meetings for the summer on the third Tuesday at 6:30 pm. Site will be the school fields at 143<sup>rd</sup> and Black Bob in Olathe. Then flying meetings the third Tuesdays of June, July, August, and finals the second Tuesday of September. We will have a business meeting the third Tuesday of September, before our Marion Outdoor Contest.
- 2) Outdoor Club Championship – There was a lot of discussion about this, and Mike B. appointed Dana F. and Jeff R. to set it up and report in May at the business meeting before the flying begins.
