A special thanks to Gary Fessler for sponsoring this event; the goody bag for winning the event was worth around \$200 and contained such treasures as tan II rubber and a Bob Opegard rubber stripper. He also put everything away which was much appreciated.

Steve Leitgen came with a new Bostonian, and got it flying well even with the prop SHAKE beating Bob Griffith's old reliable Bostonian. Greg Thomas eaked out a win in the Phantom mass launch. John Watkins and Jeff Ringlien collided, and John relaunched. Jeff's model kept going without a relaunch.

Two schools, Eastview and Moundview, had Science Olympiad students attending to trim their Elastic Launched Gliders (CLG), and they were doing well. Rahul Tiwari from Eastview brought two canard gliders, but had difficulty with the design. The gals from Moundview were doing very well with their conventional designs. They get a 30% increase on the flight score if using a canard.

A slight protest was lodged about a flight logged in after the 9:00 PM closing, and the CD was charged with doing a better job of monitoring the rules of the events. Some scores were entered wrong in the Butterfly event, but corrected after Bob Woodhouse had done his tabulation for prizes. Prizes to be awarded at the December club meeting. Once again Bob Woodhouse beat Flash Gordon in Phantom Flash.
