


DEAR SIR:

I HAVE FOUND THE SIMPLEST SOLUTION TO THE MULTI STRUT LANDING GEAR. THIS HAS ALWAYS BEEN A PROBLEM BECAUSE IT DOESN'T STAND UP WELL TO HARD LANDINGS. THE ANSWER IS A SINGLE STRUT BECAUSE IT CAN SPRING BACK FROM A HARD LANDING. BUT SOME AIRPLANES DON'T LOOK RIGHT WITH A SINGLE STRUT. TO SOLVE THIS PROBLEM I USE A PORTION OF A RUBBER BAND TO SIMULATE THE REAR STRUT. IT DOESN'T DO ANYTHING JUST LOOKS GOOD. ADDITIONAL STRUTS CAN BE ADDED USING RUBBER BANDS. DON'T WORRY THAT THE GLUE WON'T HOLD, CA STICKS TO RUBBER LIKE IT DOES TO YOUR FINGERS.
