WIRE BENDING PLIERS

Ever wish there was an easier way to bend the hook on those prop shafts? Those of us who use the "S" shaped hook on our prop shafts face enough challenges without having to put up with tools which really don't help take some of the difficulty out of the adventure. I've been using a pair of special pliers for a couple of years which are the first things I reach for when I start to make a prop shaft. The pliers are German made with one round jaw and one concave jaw as shown in the photo below. I've used them to bend wire as large as 1/16". They are indeed strong.
