Ever have those dreams of creating the best prop hook but just never got around to it? Well my fellow Tan II consumers here's a stunning drawing of what you may be looking for. It was passed along with some basic instructions to boot!

This is probably the best prop shaft/hook you'll ever see. Try making the mandrel from a bolt. Hacksaw the slot and file a groove for the shaft end. Easy! The threads on the bolt will help keep the wire from slipping while forming the hook. Make sure you wind the hook in the correct direction.

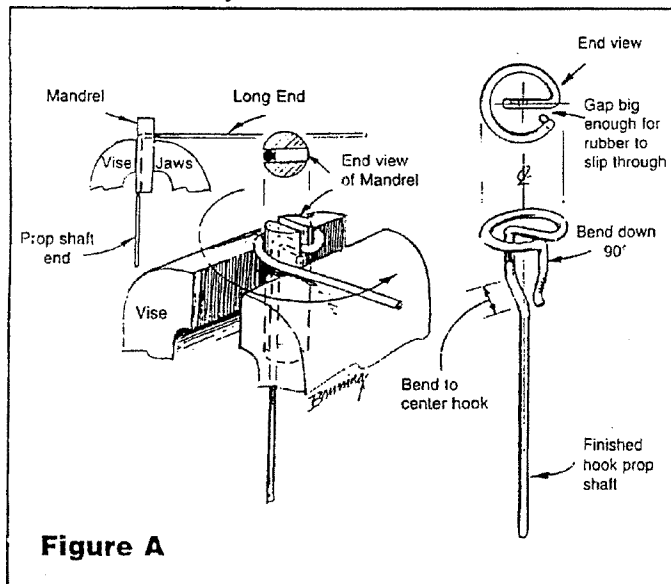
