

**Results: 65th Midwestern States Championships and Hoosier Cup FAI
Muncie Indiana, May 15-17, 2009**

The weather this year did not cooperate as it did for the past two years in May. Those who arrived early found conditions unfavorable for testing on Wednesday as storms moved through Indiana and on Thursday as strong westerly winds were the residue of the storms. Conditions on Friday, Saturday and Sunday were not ideal, but flyable. Besides weather there was an RC pylon racing contest at center field and several small lakes in low-lying areas from recent heavy rains to limit the staging areas for Free Flight. Driving on the grassy areas was risky because of soft ground. On Friday, winds were from 3-10 mph from the ESE to start but became more southerly as the day progressed. Notable flying was done by John Seymour to win Mulvihill with a locked-up Wakefield model using 45 grams of rubber. Unfortunately, he lost his airplane on the 5-minute max, a flight that was unnecessary for the win. On Saturday, the conditions were SSW winds at 7- 14mph becoming more westerly as the day progressed. At about 1:30 pm, a cool front moved through Muncie with some light rain, but the wind velocity remained the same as in the morning. The only FAI event that was contested was F1B. Because of the weather, five rounds were flown on Saturday and two were flown on Sunday.

The final day of the contest started with almost dead calm until about 8:30 am. After that, the drift was to the SW and S at about 10 mph. Long patches of near calm signified strong thermals. Notable flying on Sunday was Keith Fulmer to win the Celia Goldberg cup (again) in 1/2-A with three beautiful maxes using a Nostalgia model. Two of his flights went off the field to the south but were retrieved without incident. The major competition was in catapult glider with 8 entries. Guy Scott came out on top with two solid flights to back up his max...the only one recorded in the event.

We had a total of 31 entries, down from the 47 of last year. Several events were uncontested (only one entry) and four had no entries at all in spite of some Email pleading to hold them. Thanks to all those who paid entry fees to support the expenses of the contest but decided not to fly. Special thanks to Bob Watson who managed the contest.
