



#### From the President's Workbench Chasing:


At the SAM Champs Las Vegas, my Honda Trail 110 chase bike broke down and was not useable for 3 days of the 5 day contest. Son Chris and I decided that we needed a back up plan. Actually, I already have 2 other motorized 2 wheel vehicles – a Yamaha 125 bike and a very small 2 wheeler powered by a lawn mower engine. That little one has been in the family since about 1958. Bringing along either of those in addition to the Honda requires the use of a trailer. Don't know about you, but for me, a very short trailer is nearly impossible to back up, making maneuvering most difficult. Steve knows how to do this but he wasn't successful in teaching me. Anyhow, I bought a bicycle. It straps on to the outside of the Honda fairly securely. At the field, it works out OK, and the exercise is a good idea too. One of the neatest things about the bike is that I was able to buy a 7 speed 26" bike, brand new, for less than I paid to have a flat tire fixed on the Honda: \$76.00 [after 10% off due to the missing seat bolt]. This time of year, there are a lot of bikes available on special – take a look. If you drive a car, take a look also at the various kinds of clip-on racks that are sold for carrying a bicycle.


