



Caution Flags.

These should be obvious. Be alert to these warning signals:

- Environmental temperature s greater that 90 F (inhibit normal transfer of excess body heat).
- Humidity greater than 60% (impedes evaporation of sweat and its related cooling effect).
- · Poor conditioning and acdimatization.
- Occlusive dothing that insulates the body and impedes sweat evaporation.
- Pre-existing dehydration due to low fluid intake or medication.
- Diuretics leading to depleted body water (this doesn't imply discontinuing diuretics.)
- · Overly strenuous physical activity (most are aware of this but tend to push on).

Summary. Common sense and good judgment are key words to prevention of heat illness. Observe the following rules, on and off the flying field:

- Heat-related illnesses usually occur on the first day or two of a heat wave or extended outing before acclimatization has occurred.
- Know your physical limits-function with them.
- · Drink more than adequate fluids, regularly and throughout the day.
- Model retrieval chases should be motorized, not on foot or alone, if at all possible.
- Ingest fluids freely while on chases.
- Use cell phones or 2-way radios to maintain communications with someone at the launch site; make certain others are aware of your location.
- Stay out of the sun when possible.

[Warning Signal: When you are in the summer heat, keep a check on how often you are feeling the call of nature. If you go more than a couple of hours, you are likely behind on your water intake.-Ed.]

Prez Speaks



PMAC's fall flying season begins on September 17th, with hopefully cooler weather. George Morris will be the CD. Over the summer I have several kits I plan to build, I hope you do too. If you are tired of D gas, remember we are now flying FAC events. There will be many FAC events flown in our December and January contests. Don't forget the October WESTFAC contest; see the newsletter for details. Kevin McCue had a beautiful Bellanca Junior at the last

contest and it flew extremely well for such a small model. I remember building one when I was eleven. Mine did not look nearly as nice as Kevin's as I could afford only 15 cents; 10 cents for the kit and 5 cents for a tube of glue! I did not fly my Phantom Flash at the Dome as test flights at home showed it flew very poorly. I discovered it had a cracked spar at the wing mount, not obvious until stress was put on it. I fixed this but the wing had a warp I could not get out. It was covered with pre-shrunk tissue that had been lightly doped. I discovered (on other models as well) that dope continues to shrink long after applied. I made a new wing, attached tissue to a frame and pre-shrunk it twice. Shig Saimo had sent me ads for Eze Dope and the maker claimed it was stable when dry. I re-shrunk the tissue with a 5% solution of Eze Dope and water. The dried tissue looks great. We will see how it turns out. Since Eze Dope is water-based I would be hesitant to try it on small models without pre-shrinking but on larger models with stronger frames the tissue can be applied wet with dilute Eze Dope and then coated with a stronger mix. When dry it is fuel proof. It will be interesting to see how it works.



His P-30 tried to escape after the wing didn't DT and with only the tail popped it still flew in a powerful thermal. He gave chase and I lost it at eight minutes and change while tracking

Tom Gaylor, Kevin McCue and I flew in FAC Embryo and Kevin took the win for another Kanone. We folded up camp around 2 pm when the heat started affecting people.
