

# **Vice-Prez Speaks**



### My Freeflight summer trip to Europe

Brigitte and I had a great time in Germany, France, Switzerland and Romania (4 weeks total). There was much driving involved with 3 different rental cars. It was hard traveling with 2 carry-ons, 2 large, heavy suitcases and the heavy 56" long F1E model box, especially if the hotel room was on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor and there was no elevator.

I had qualified for the F1E World Championships in Turda, Romania together with Geralyn Jones, Bob Sifleet and Tom loerger. Sadly Tom had medical issues and had to drop out on short notice. The U.S. did not have a full team and also did not have a Junior team. For me it was the 3<sup>rd</sup> time competing at an F1E World Champs in Romania in an area called Transylvania. I had been there in 2003 and 2017.

The contest flying was at a place called Tankodrom, a hill belonging to the military which had 2 slopes available depending on the wind direction. On the Senior World Champs day we had to fly from the slope that went down and after a relative short distance climbed up higher again on the other side of the valley. This valley dropped down to the left of the competitor and had the lowest point about 1 mile from his launch point. For the first 3 rounds the wind was fairly light and variable in direction. My first flight was stalling a bit which gave me a 35 second drop (4 min. max) even though my test flight right before was fine. My 2<sup>nd</sup> round flight was a nice max (4 min.) which gave me confidence. The 3<sup>rd</sup> round was disaster when the model stalled badly and after 115 seconds disappeared behind a knoll (the max had increased to 5 min.). On this model the stab mount had broken shortly before and after my repair I had not noticed that now the stab did at times not touch the head of the adjustment screw. For the 4th round the wind speed had increased much and I had added some lead weight for penetration. The wind came across this valley and even a few degrees further from the right. This required flying down the valley to the left with the wind coming from the back. I was happy to max this flight (5 min. max) - only 8 others maxed this round also. For the 5th round the wind eased a bit. I flew a lighter model with added lead and maxed nicely (5 min. max) and landed about 1 mile away - only 12 others maxed this round also.

Because of the difficult wind direction nobody maxed out, which is very unusual. The new F1E World Champion dropped a total of 55 seconds. If I would have maxed round 3 I would have beaten him. I am happy with my 15<sup>th</sup> place overall. Bob Sifleet was 33<sup>rd</sup> and Geralyn Jones 35<sup>th</sup>.
