ON THE LIGHTER SIDE - H.Haupt



Larry Bagalini, representing the famous Star Link-Flite Tech, brought along 3 awards to give out. Unfortunately two of the recipients were not in attendance. Larry said one of the awards was for all the support he has gotten from Bill Booth over the last several years. Another was for "all the great gizmos" that Gerald Sullivan has provided for the last several years as well. Neither of these gentlemen made it to the banquet, but Larry wanted to make it know that he very much appreciated their services. The third plaque was for John Oldenkamp, as John has done a lot of work for Larry in putting together planes, testing them, and reporting on them. He has been at this for about 5 years. We didn't have a traditional business meeting, other than the topic of a meeting site which still needs to be resolved. Larry Bagalini started it off with a Bob White designed Coupe, available for a mere \$297.00. It was very nicely done, with a dihedral in the horizontal stab and twin outboard fins. The plane featured blue and yellow finish, very attractive. The next plane was another coupe, but more high-tech. Had a standard tail, but with some special features. The "D-Box" style comes fully finished and ready to fly for only \$560.00. The third plane Larry brought was a bare-bones "Miss World's Fair", which Larry said was built in only 12 hours. Larry Miller then showed us his Ramrod, which was nicely done in red and yellow. It can flown with either an .049 or an .051 engine. It has a 250 sq. in. wing, and clean, classic lines to the whole plane.

John Oldenkamp finished off the show and tell segment with his latest F1E magnet steering plane. He said it should weigh 20 oz., but only weighs about 16 oz. It is his "windy weather" version. Attractively done with orange center wing section and horizontal stab, and bright red outer wing panels and vertical stab.

We then took a group photo and adjourned shortly thereafter.
