

San Diego Orbiteers Monthly Meeting Minutes December 14, 2012

It was previously announced that this may be the last of the monthly meetings, so we had eight members show up tonight, including: President Don Bartick, Frank Allen, Mark Chomyn, Howard Haupt, Larry Miller, Mike Pykelny (with home-made cookies!), John Hutchison, and John Merrill.

Meeting called to order 7:05 p.m. by President Don Bartick.

There was some discussion of last month's contest (November monthly at Otay Mesa), and whether to include, and how to include gliders. Pretty simple, a format will be lower in the notes of the minutes.

The big topic of the night: do we continue with our monthly meetings? Currently we do not get a turnout to warrant the cost of the room. Here's the verdict:

- 1. The newsletter will stay a monthly publication. All agreed that Howard is doing a fantastic job getting the E.T. together every month, and all want to see that continue.
- Motion made by Don B. to establish a board of trustees, have quarterly meetings with the trustees, and have the quarterly meeting replace the monthly general meetings. The motion was seconded by Mike Pykelny. No discussion – motion passed unanimously.
- 3. First Trustee action: establish the Board of Trustees. The Trustees shall consist of Don Bartick (Chairman), Mike Pykelny, Mark Chomyn, Larry Miller, John Hutchison, John Merrill, and Howard Haupt. Howard shall retain the honor of being Treasurer, Editor, and keep track of Membership. John M. shall remain Secretary. At the quarterly meetings, a quorum shall be a minimum of four of the above Board members.

The next item addressed was the 2013 contest schedule. It may appear elsewhere in the E.T., but overall it is very similar to the

2012 schedule. The quick reference is as follows:

Jan. 27th P-30, Feb. 17th Small OT Rubber Stick, Mar.10th Coupe, Apr. 21st P-30, May 18-19th Lost Hills Dual Club Annual, Jun 9th Coupe, July 4th Mooney Annual, July 21st P-30, Aug. 18th OT Rub Sm. Stick, Sept. 15th Coupe, Oct. 20th P-30, Nov. 17th OT Rub Sm. Stick, Dec. 15th, Coupe. There are other contests of note as well, including 3 for Scale Staffel. The first will be a biggie – WESTFAC IV April 24th-27th. Others will be Aug.5th and Oct.27th. Scamps are holding contests Feb.24th, March 17th, and June 16th. Lost Hills will have the U.S.F.F. Champs Sept. 20th-22nd.

S.W.FAI Champs are in Nevada/Boulder City October 26th-27th.

As mentioned earlier, we needed to set a true format for the monthly contests, to avoid further confusion. There will be 3 events at the monthly: the "Featured Event" as above such as P-30, Coupe, or OT Rubber Small Stick. The Power event will be the second event, and Glider will be the third. Glider shall consist of 3 different types: Hand Launch, Catapult, and Discuss Launch (or Wing Tip Launch). This format eliminated the P-20 seen on the contest announcements seen for the last several years. P-20 was not being flown enough to keep it on the schedule. A motion for the above was made by Mike P., and seconded by Mark C. The motion passed unanimously. The contests for 2013 shall be 8:00a.m. to Noon.

We decided to cancel the December 2012 contest. Heavy rain was expected throughout the weekend, and the following weekends are too close to the holidays.

Annual Banquet: Larry Miller working on January 26th, but had not been confirmed as of tonight.

Funds were received from the S.W. Challenge, and it was decided the club would donate 80% of those funds to the FAI Junior Program.

Show and Tell: Mark Chomyn showed us plans to a Berkeley Culver "V" with laser cut parts in a "short kit" from

JustKittingAround.com. It was only \$15.00 for the 30ish inch wing span plane.

Next, he had an electric power unit made specifically for paper airplanes. It came with a charger for about \$18.00.

Last but not least, he had a complete Berkeley kit of the Sky Ray he obtained via Ebay, as well as the Comet "Phantom Fury".

At some point we called an end to the meeting. Before we left, we all agreed that it seemed somewhat bitter-sweet, knowing this was the very last time we would be meeting at this nice facility on a monthly basis, the end of an era.

No indoor flying followed.

Secretary's Note: Thank you to all that responded to the email regarding the monthly meetings. You were asked if you wanted them to continue, be quarterly, or just dropped all-together. Several responses were obtained, and all very much appreciated...thanks again! I hope to see everyone at the big banquet later this month.

The feature event is P-30


Power is a non feature event.

From the Flying Aces, Originally from Air Wars by A.C. Anson You don't have to be a sculptor to use this simple six-step formula to achieve realistic-looking pilots. And you'll get brownie points from some of the scale judges. (Enlarge or reduce these drawings for different scale pilots. You can substitute blue foam for balsa.) Step 1: Cut this center template out of ¹/₄-inch or ¹/₈-inch balsa or scrap. Note: Only this center section has the nose. Step 2: All other laminates must conform to the center shape. Start sanding to match. Step 3: Cut underside of pilot head to begin to approximate neck width. Step 2 Step 4: Using finished pilot in Step 6 as a guide, draw outline of face and head on flat face in Step 5: Continue sanding to finish head, neck, and shoulders. Add laminates to achieve full should width. Match drawing in Step 6. Thin nose slightly if using 1/4-inch sheet. Step 6: Paint finished pilot. Paint on goggles or cut out of bond paper and glue on. Flesh tone comes ready mixed in watercolor tubes at your local art store. Detail lines in dark brown. Hollow-out base of pilot for lightness.

Haggart-Bowden 2-minute Precision RULES: Aircraft must be a NON-Pylon type, conforming to the 8 oz./sq. ft, 80 oz./cu. Inch and L2/100 rules. The power shall be spark ignition engine(s). All flights shall be rise off ground. The time target for each flight is 120 seconds (2 minutes). Each flight will be scored as the difference between actual flight time and the target time. Each contestant will make 3 flights. On any flight, a D/T action at less than 4 minutes will result in a ZERO flight time (120 score for that flight). The winner will be the flyer that accumulates the total nearest 3 perfect 2-minute flights.
