

Showcasing projects and completed FF models of the Orbiteers. This month John Merrill is sharing some of his work in progress.


1. A Dumas Walnut-scale kit of a P-39. Walnuts generally have a 17 ½ inch wind span. Wing half covered with domestic tissue. Built per plan, but added 1/8" sheet balsa to nose to avoid having ugly clay on the nose later, I got the idea from Frank Allen. Also gave it a slightly lifting stab.





# FROM THE WORKSHOP – (Continued)

2. Kind of hard to see, but also on another building board is a P-51B Mustang from Golden Age Reproductions. The cool thing about the kit is it can be made into one of four different models of Mustangs: Standard B Model, B Model with a Malcolm hood canopy, D Model, or D Model Racer of the 1948-49 Thompson Trophy racer of Anson Johnson. Includes decals for all of the above. The I chose to build was the B Model with the Malcolm hood, just because its different, not often seen in models.






# FROM THE WORKSHOP - (Continued)


# FROM THE WORKSHOP – (Continued)

4. Some folks saw my Gollywock at the last contest at Otay, but it is still in process of being finished. It still needs a D.T. (which is new to me), and a new nose. My first flight bent the prop shaft, so that needs to be redone anyway. May put a folding prop on it, but have not decided yet. I may need some help from our local experts at the field to make it fly properly, but hopefully it can compete someday.

### HAND LAUNCH GLIDER & CATAPULT GLIDER

Hand Launch Glider & Catapult Glider will to be launched from an established glider pen on the field. Max's are 120 seconds and all flights count.

### E36/A/B ELECTRIC

E36: 36" Max. wing span, min. weight 120 gms, 2 cell Lithium Polymer battery pack max, fixed surfaces except DT. Folding props are allowed. Hand launch flights. 6 attempts to complete 3 official 120 sec flights with 15 sec motor runs, 40 sec minimum official flight. Fly off flights have motor run reduced to 10 sec first fly off, then reduced to 5 sec and continue at 5 sec until 120 sec flight time is not achieved.

AMA A: Any number of cells of any rechargeable battery technology, fixed surfaces except DT, 6 attempts to complete 3 official 120 sec flights with 10 sec motor runs, 40 sec minimum official flight. Fly off flights have motor run reduced to 5 sec and continued at 5 sec until 120 sec flight time is not achieved.

AMA B: Same as A except variable surfaces are allowed.

### NIGHT GAS FLYING

All engine classes combined. Event window between 6pm – 9pm. Engine runs in accordance with aircraft classification; i.e., AMA or Nostalgia.

### DAKOTA

Target time 60 seconds. Score based on differential of actual flight time to target time. Lowest score of 3 flights combined.

### MINI FAI EVENTS Low stress format

F1G, F1H, F1J/P: First five (5) flights must be flown from the established line between 7:00 – 12:00 AM. 120 sec max Fly-off in ½ hour rounds starting at 1:00 PM. 15min rounds in sequence. 15min between end of round and beginning of next one. Fly-off round max: 1st 150sec, 2nd 180sec, 3rd 210sec, 4th 240sec, 5th 300sec, 6th 360sec and so on. Fly-off rounds may be compressed by consensus of the participants and the CD.
