#### **Board Meeting: From page 1**

#### **New Business:**

- Outdoor and Indoor Competition Records. A few months of competition records from 2013 are missing. Howard has printed all that was turned in to him in the E.T., but a few months of outdoor, and several months of indoor are missing. The results shall be printed elsewhere on what we do have. John Hutchison made the motion to accept the points of the 7 out of 10 outdoor contests that we have records for as the final points accumulation for the year. The motion was seconded by Mike Pykelny, and passed unanimously.
- 2. We have recently heard from two of our board members that wish to resign. Howard is no longer available to attend our meetings, so wished to resign from the board. After much discussion, we decided it would be advisable to retain him as a "Board Member at Large". meaning he does not have to attend meetings, and will not have voting privileges, but will be able to maintain the position of not only newsletter editor, but also our Treasurer and Membership Coordinator. Mark Chomyn made the motion spelled out above, and John Merrill seconded. The motion passed unanimously. Larry Miller is resigning as well, due to health issues. Larry has had several duties over the past several years, including Competition Director, and being in charge of our annual banquet. Mark Chomyn was railroaded/volunteered to be the new Competition Director, and will start immediately by applying to the AMA for next year's sanctions for our outdoor contests (Record Trials). John Merrill made the motion to accept Mark for Comp. Dir. Seconded by Mike Pykelny, and passed unanimously.
- The annual banquet is all set for Saturday, January 25<sup>th</sup> 2014 in Kearny Mesa. It will be at the same restaurant

- as last year, and will be the same price. There will be a flyer elsewhere in the E.T., or an email blast will follow soon. John H. made the motion to have the club put in \$100.00 for raffle prizes for the banquet. The motion was seconded by Mark Chomyn, and passed unanimously. If anyone wishes to donate kits/prizes for the banquet, they will certainly be welcomed.
- 4. There was much discussion pertaining to the terms of the Board members. When the Board was established last year, there was no mention of term limits or parameters. John H. made the motion that board members be in place for 2 years. The motion was seconded by Mike Pykelny, and passed unanimously.
- 5. The contest schedule for 2014 was discussed and set, with a few dates being tentative. Mark Chomyn will submit these dates to Howard, who will include them in this E.T., or the next one. The first contest will be the day after the banquet in January.
- 6. John Hutchison has the 2014 schedule for the Indoor contests at Grossmont College. The first contest will feature A-6, and will be on Jan. 5<sup>th</sup>. All indoor contests are on the first Sunday of every month, unless otherwise noted. John will submit the dates to Howard shortly for submission into the E.T.

Contest Reports: none.

Open Discussion: Don and Arline Bartick are planning their annual pilgrimage to the big contest in Eloy, AZ in January. He says it is always a fun contest, and well worth the time to attend.

The next meeting will be Thursday, March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2014 at Mike Pykelny's home in Poway. Meeting adjourned at 8:59p.m. Once again, thanks to Mark and Nancy for hosting.

#### FROM THE WORKSHOP


Frank Allen has report in on several build projects underway. The first is a new line of Guillows profile scale kits, as shown in the following photo. This one is a P-40.




Frank also reported that he is finishing up on a Guillows 18 inch Sopwith Camel that someone else had started. Pictures follow.






