Contest Event and Field Rules

- 1. This is a Cat III National Cup Contest, All AMA, NFFS and SAM rules will be followed.
- Open member fees are \$20. Junior and Senior Fliers entry is \$0 for all events.
- 3. Contestants are required to complete each flight card, secure a timer, have the flight timed and present the cased to the contest director for recording at the completion of each official flight or attempt. The CD will record the time and return the card. At the enth emet, all flight cards are to be turned in to the CDs. Except for HLC and Cataput Glider, each flight must be recorded before attempting another flight. HLG and Cat. Glider may record several socrose before turning in cards.
- 4. Registration will begin each day 30 minutes before official flights begin and close at 4 PM on Saturday and 1 PM on Sunday.
- 5. Old Timer Event Rules: Model must be 1951 (and certain designs up to 1957) as per SAM rules. Spark (gnition only. Engine Run Times: Pylon or Fuselage models 20 seconds RIC AG R 123 Event models open to any SAM eligible Antique or Old Timer model powered by an 0.8 R 23. All maxes are 2 minutes. All attempts are 20 seconds. Flvotfs will have a decreasing engine run format.
- Golden Age Gas Event. Limited to models designed between 1957 and 1969. Powered by either TD. 049-051 or Holland Hornet 049-051. Flight
 rules the same as Nostaloja Gas. (9 sec. HL and 10 Sec. VTO/ROG)
- 7. E-20 : Flight Rules are 20 second motor run/90 second max. 20 second attempt. Flyoff flights are 10 second motor run and 120 second max.
- 8. Wock Event: The event includes any version of the Wock series including the Vargowock. Flown to SAM rules. 2 Min max.
- 9. The LO-Ooc Scale event will be run in accord with the current VMC Rules (see website) Judging will be by Bill Switt on Saturday attemporal evening on the field. Official flights will be flown Sunday beginning around 8:15 AM, Special arrangements may be made with the judge for judging or tying at different times. Models that have won First Place in an 3 contests in the last year are not eligible for prize for one year. Two models may be entered by each contestant. A special end of season set of trophics is offered by Place Grell to the highest finishers that three contests.
- 10. Fun Scale. Judging is based on fidliety to plan, which must be provided. Voting for models will take place at the Collecto on Sat=urday evening. Flights will take place after LoDoc Scale on Sunday AM.
- 11.One Design Event The One Design Event is sponsored by Bill Vanderbeek. Nostalgia rules apply for engine runs. Any Nostalgia legal 049/051 may be used. Cash award for First, Second and Third place if flying the models of the year. If flying past One Design models, then you pick from the orizes available.
- 12. Classic Towline: The event allows any size towline glider to be flown up to 575 sq. in. total projected area. Any circle tow equipment must be "locked out." Any evidence of circle tow during flight will be cause for disqualification. Three flights of 3 minutes are recorded. Flyoff flights are 4min. in duration until a winner is declared.
- 13. Dakota Time Target: The model must be a faithful replica of a VecoDiumas Dakota biplane. It may be powered by any nostalgia legal .049 engine. The lifer must set the time target in advance of the light, with a minimum flight of 30 seconds.  16.SAM 8 Perpetual Award-Old Timer Cup: This perpetual trophy is sponsored by SAM 8 for the flier who amasses the most time in any ignition
- powered old timer or Antique event at any 2 of our 3 outdoor meets. The highest score at each meet for each contestant will be recorded. Flyoffs, if needed, will be at the Fall Annual. In addition to the trophy, the winner will receive \$100.

Contest Information:

•All official lights will be launched from an identified area (box). P-30 and Vintage in separate areas. •P-30 models winding area will be separate from the launch area and identified as such.

Vintage 1 and 2 models may be either handlaunched or ROG/VTO.

•P-30 models will have a standard 2 minute max and follow AMA rules for flvoffs; however, we will have 5 official flights before any flyoffs begin. All flights will be in rounds.


•All Vintage models must be weighed and stamped prior to any official flight. Vintage power models must be identified by Vintage era on the wing to qualify. P-30 models will be assumed to meet weight requirements. •2024-25 NFFS Vintage Power and Wakefield rules will be followed. P-30 will adhere to AMA rules other than the requirement for 5 official flights prior to any flyoffs.


Entry Fee: \$10 per event. If you fly in more than one Vintage class, each added will be \$10 extra.
