NC Grand Champion Scoring

The National Cup Grand Champion is determined by summing a flier's four best overall NC scores, proportioned to the score of the winner of each cup, with no more than two scores allowed of the four gas power events. To be eligible for the Grand Champion Award, the flier must have scores in at least two different NC event classes (Gas Power, Rubber Power, Electric, Glider).

The winner of each cup receives 100 points. If the second place individual has 1/2 of the point total of the winner of that cup, that individual would receive 50 points. The four best cup scores for each individual are then added to determine the overall Grand Champion. Only a total of the four highest National Cup scores may be counted even if an individual accumulated scores in more than four cups.
