

NFFS HALL OF FAME COMMITTEE GUIDELINES

1. The purpose of the Hall of Fame (HOF) committee is to accept nominations and select inductees based on submitted nominations and supporting documents. It is not a popularity contest, but rather a recognition of an individual's contributions to free flight model aviation over the years.
2. NFFS president appoints a HOF chair after the current years Symposium has been published (usually around the free flight NATS date).
3. That chair then searches for appropriate volunteer committee members (preferably a total of 5 including the chair). This will provide a tie breaker for voting purposes. Selection of members from different parts of the U.S. and with diverse modeling interests is also desirable.
4. The Committee chair will coordinate with the NFFS Digest editor to advertise the committee's acceptance of HOF nominations in the November/December NFFS Digest, Facebook page and NFFS Web Page.
5. Nominations must be submitted in a single document to the HOF chair and will not be accepted in multiple submissions. Information for HOF nominations are located on the NFFS web page.
6. Deadline for submission of nominations is March 1. As they are received, nominations will be forwarded to committee members for consideration. It is important that selections are made early in March, as the deadline for submission of inductee symposium articles is April 1.
7. The committee may use e-mail, phone calls and video conferences to discuss candidates.
8. Keep in mind that there are no specific restrictions on numbers of inductees, other than they should truly be deserving of this honor.
9. Once the inductees are selected the Chair will notify the selected candidates, the candidates' sponsor, the NFFS President and the Symposium editor. The inductee will then be instructed to put together the Symposium article (two pages total, including photo's). In the event the candidate is unable to complete the article the chair will create one from the submitted materials of the sponsor. Both the inductee and sponsor must be instructed to keep the selection confidential until publication of the symposium.
10. After the Symposium is published and the selection of a new HOF committee chair, the current years chair shall forward non-selected nominations to the new chair for consideration in the current year's class. (This will only occur for two cycles, after that the nomination must be updated and resubmitted)

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
